



## Call for proposals: 2028 European Set Theory Conference

*March 30, 2026*

In 2026, we celebrate the tenth instalment of the *European Set Theory Conference* series, which will be held in Helsinki, Finland. These conferences bring together specialists representing a broad spectrum of areas within set theory and, even more broadly, mathematical logic. They typically last five days, traditionally host close to—and often more than—100 participants, and are distinguished by the Hausdorff Lecture, delivered by the most recent recipient(s) of the Hausdorff Medal of the European Set Theory Society.

With this well-established tradition, and on the occasion of the tenth instalment of the ESTC, the Board of the ESTS invites members and friends of the Society to submit bids to host the 2028 European Set Theory Conference. Please note that the Society, represented by its Board, remains closely involved in shaping the scientific programme of the event. In particular, it is responsible—in collaboration with the local organisers—for appointing the Chair of the Scientific Committee and approving its members. Additionally, we recommend that the organising team be represented on the Scientific Committee to ensure close coordination between organisational and scientific aspects of the conference.

To this end, the ESTS Board invites proposals for hosting the 2028 conference. Proposals (of up to two pages) should include the following information:

1. Proposed dates
2. Venue and location details
3. Funding plan
4. Tentative Organising Committee
