## Dear Members of the European Set Theory Society,

We invite nominations for the **Hausdorff Medal 2026**. The Hausdorff Medal is awarded biennially for the most influential work in set theory published within the five years preceding the award. The next medal will be presented at the **Tenth European Set Theory Conference in Helsinki**.

The deadline for nominations is **1 December 2025 (CET)**. Eligible works are peer-reviewed papers published in print or digital form between **1 January 2020 and 30 November 2025**. Each nomination requires the support of at least **two ESTS members**, and each member may support only **one nomination**. Nominees do not need to be ESTS members. Self-nominations are not allowed, and current board members are not eligible for nomination.

## A nomination should include:

- A single nomination letter, signed by the nominators, of **maximum three pages**, describing the significance of the work.
- An electronic copy of the published version of the work.

The decision will be made by a designated committee in consultation with the ESTS Board. Please submit your nominations by the above deadline to <a href="mailto:european.set.theory@gmail.com">european.set.theory@gmail.com</a>.
